Don't forget to clean your Air Conditioner.



With warmer weather on the horizon its important to maintain your A/C so it can perform at the optimum level.

It is your responsibility as tenant to maintain the filter system on air conditioners whether it is a split system or ducted. This should be done at least once a month. This will ensure your unit stays in good running order and assist in maintaining a healthy environment.

- Filters should be removed carefully to minimise dust. Do not use vacuum cleaners as they can damage the fins.
- Wash the filters with warm soapy water. Do not use harsh cleaners or scourers as they can damage the filters
- Filters are then to be left to completely dry prior to reinstalling
